**Terms and Conditions:**

- i. Maximum weight of trunk of General Cargo should not exceed 20 kg and value should be below Rs-50,000/- if it exceeds away bill will be required .
- ii. **Minimum Chargeable weight General Cargo-50kgs or Rs, gross weight, or Rs-3000/- whichever is higher one way per client**
- iii. General cargo shall not include precious metals & precious jewellery, precious & semi- precious stones, coins and diamonds. General cargo shall include (but not limited to) standees, panels, props etc. The cargo classification norms & declaration as followed by commercial airlines from time to time shall be bench marked.
- iv. No Vaulting of General cargo would be done at the venue.
- v. Insurance needs to be covered by the shipper for the General cargo, in case of any loss, damage, BVCwon't be responsible.
- vi. Surface locations / non-Online (\*) mentioned in Annexure A shall be serviced at an additional charge of INR 1500/- per shipping note.
- vii. BVC Logistics reserves the right to change the rates, terms, and conditions of its offer at any time.
- viii. Shipper & the Consignee shall ensure to comply with all the government and statutory requirements and tax formalities in advance to facilitate transportation and delivery. BVC shall not be liable for any non-compliance by the customer.
- ix. All Government and other statutory taxes, levies to include, GST shall be borne by the customer as applicable on the day of the shipment.

**Terms & Conditions: -**

2. The CUSTOMER hereby indemnifies and absolves BVC Logistics Pvt. Ltd. and BVC group companies from all liabilities which may arise while carrying out pick-ups, transportation and delivery of any or all the shipments. It is expressly understood that in no event will any claim be made by the CUSTOMER against M/s BVC Logistics Pvt. Ltd and BVC group companies in case of loss, damage, theft, infidelity etc., of any of the shipments handled on the customer's behalf.

3. In the unfortunate event of loss and/or damage of goods, the role and liability of BVC shall be restricted to initiating the claim lodgment process with the Insurance company, to enable the CUSTOMER to claim insurance.

4. To the extent permitted by Applicable Law, the Customer hereby releases BVC from any and all liability or responsibility towards the Customer or anyone claiming through or under the Customer by way of subrogation or otherwise (including an insurance company) for any loss or damage to the consignments. By signing this document, the Customer accepts it has the authority from its own Insurance company to give the subrogation waiver. The Customer indemnifies BVC from all direct and indirect claims.
