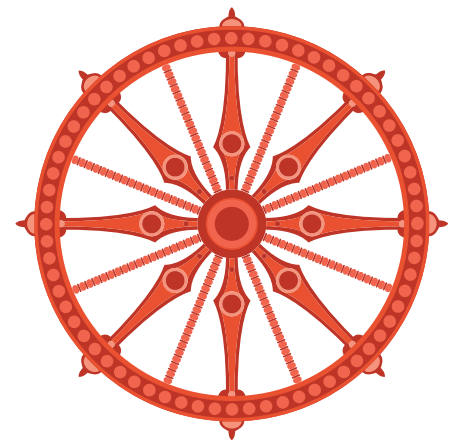

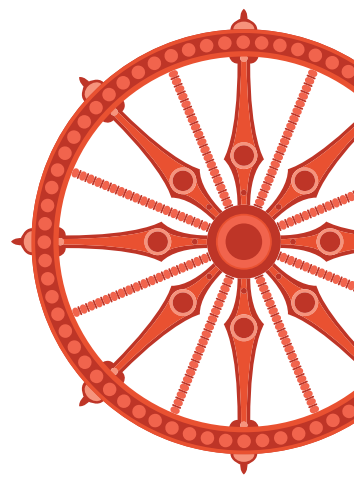

### GJEPC Meets TGJTA & ITDCA to Enhance Thai Participation in Upcoming IIJS & SAJEX Shows

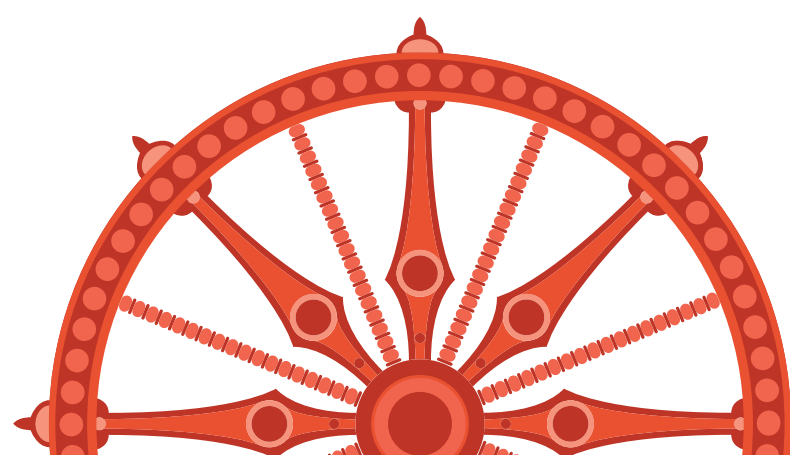

In a bid to boost bilateral cooperation, GJEPC held a series of constructive meetings with key stakeholders from Vietnam's gemstone and investment sectors.

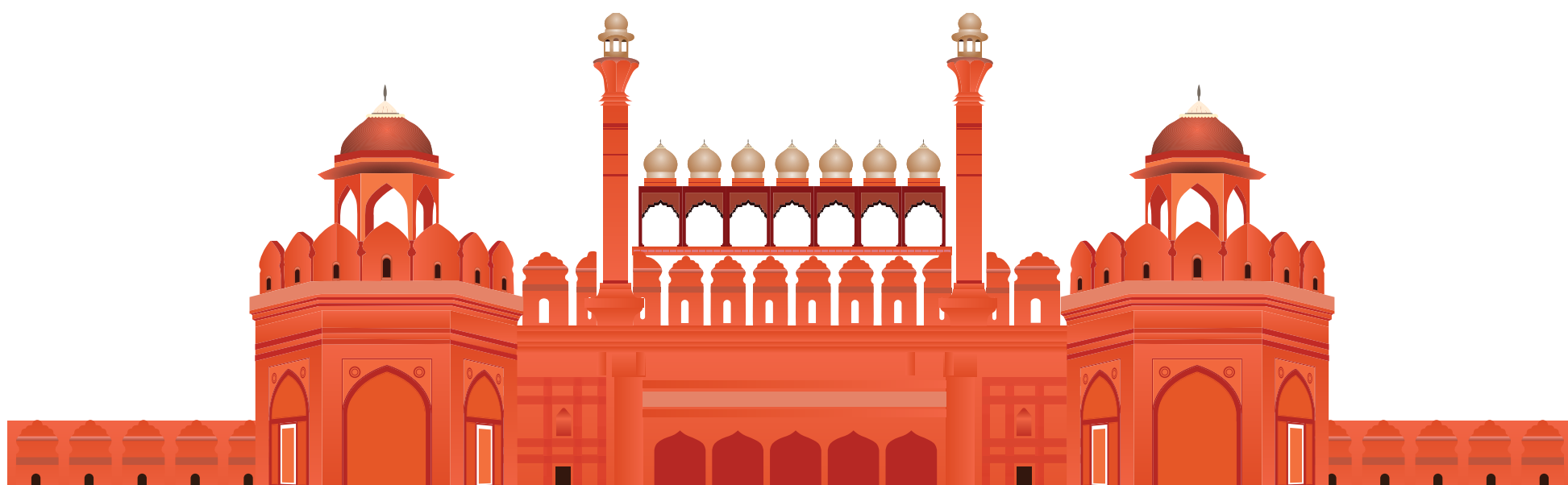

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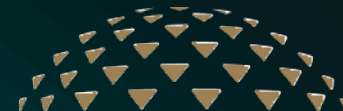
