GJEPC's IIJS Bharat Retailers' Connect in Mysuru Draws Strong Trade Interest

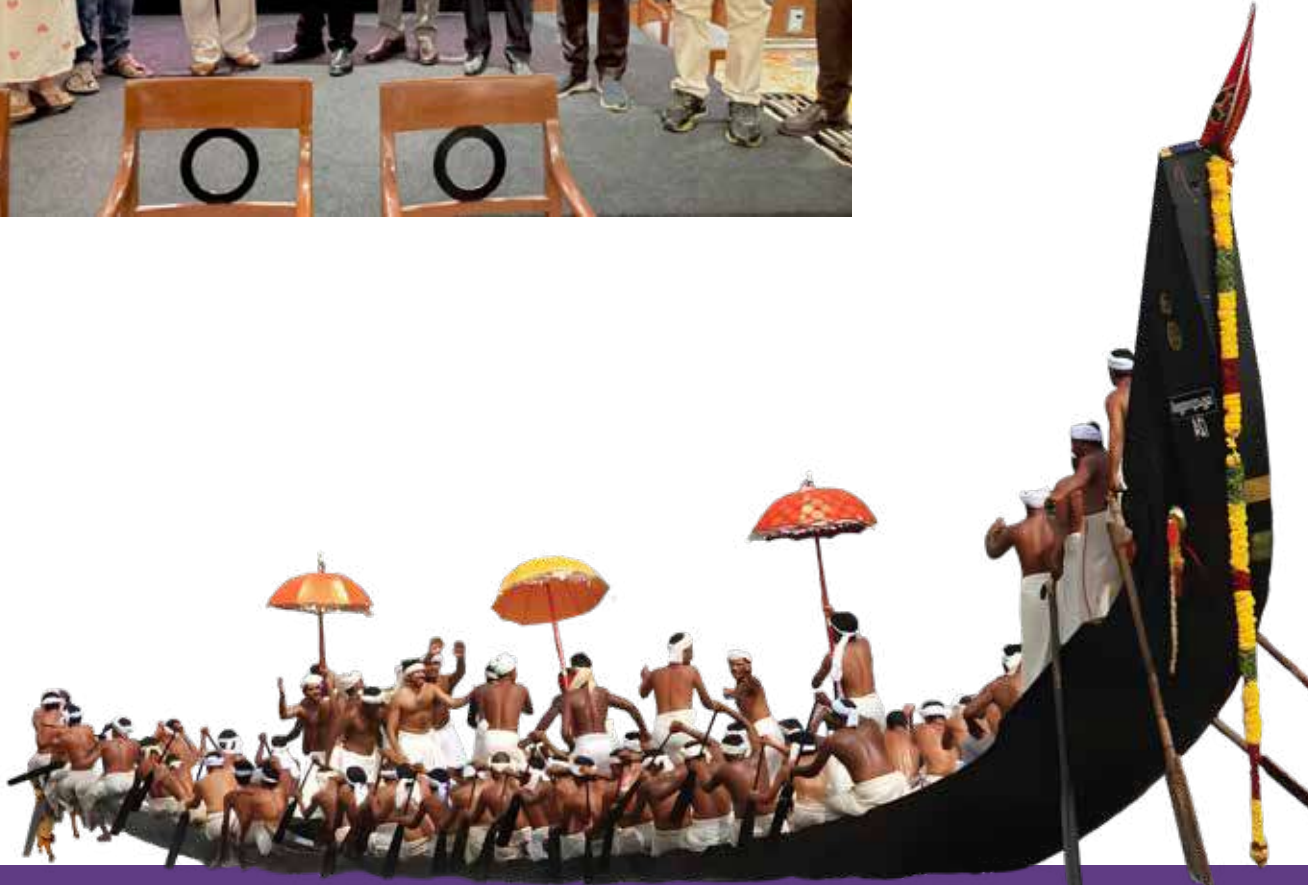

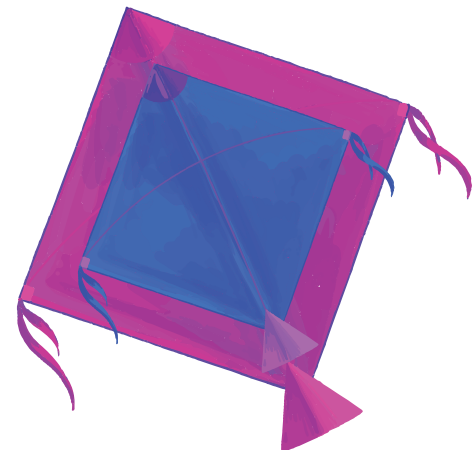
