**Sub: Barring of Export due to EPCG License Compliance Issues**

Dear All,

This is to inform you all that we understand from calls received from a number of our exporters that such exporters of Gem and Jewellery holding EPCG Licenses have either not fulfilled their export obligation or have not submitted proof of discharge of export obligation /request for bond cancellation. The department has placed alert in the EDI system against the name of the EPCG License holders that compliance is pending and the License holders are unable to file their import/export related documents.

We had done a meeting with all clearing and forwarding agents at PCCCC. Mumbai and understand the problems faced on ground. Accordingly the Council has requested in writing to the Commissioner of Customs that a grace period of thirty days may please be granted to the EPCG License holders to submit proof of discharge of export obligation and request for cancellation of bonds and in the meanwhile, the export clearances should be allowed.

In view of the above, it is requested that all the members should immediately submit proof of discharge of export obligation and or request for bond cancellation, if not already done.
