I / We confirm that I / we alone will be responsible for such claim(s), if any and undertake to indemnify and keep indemnified the Council at all times from and against any and all claims or responsibilities to which the Council may be subjected in this behalf. The Council will not be responsible for any dispute or claim with any State Government and/or Central Government bodies/agencies/departments or any other autonomous bodies including the consumer courts and appropriate forums.
- The Council will not be a party to any dispute with the Sales Tax, Income Tax, Customs, Excise or Octroi departments or with any other local, state or central authorities which are applicable and/or enforced on me / us.

- An Application without the payment shall be rejected. However, timely submission of the Registration form along with all the relevant supporting documents and the payment does not guarantee selection in favour of the Applicant. All rights with respect to the selection or otherwise vests only with the Council and the Applicant agree to abide by the same without any protest or demur.
- All Applicants should have their allotted booths at Prelude to IJS 2018 and the Membership and renewal advised as on date of the Registration form. In absence of the same, the Council reserves the right to reject any such form.
- If any Applicant or any of Associated Enterprises is having any amount outstanding with and payable to Council, in any manner whatsoever, the Council shall have full right to reject the form without assigning any reason. The participant should ensure to avoid the occurrence of incidents like tripping on the runway, wardrobe malfunction, etc., and the Council will not be responsible for the same.
- The Participant has to arrange for assistants during fittings & security of all their products and the Council will not be responsible for the same.
- The selected Applicants will get badges and or passes as per the allotment approved by the Council based on the capacity of seating.
- All Applicants are required to carefully read & understand all the Terms & Conditions forming part of this Application form before signing the same.

ANNEXURE – I

STANDARD TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Standard Terms & Conditions shall apply to all the selected Applicants ("Participants") who registered their interest for selection at the **Prelude to IJS 2018** to be organized & hosted by the Gem & Jewellery Export Promotion Council on 8th August, 2018. By applying for participation for Prelude for IJS 2018, the Applicant is deemed to have accepted these T&Cs without any qualifications.

1. DEFINITION

- "Application" means Registration form and Standard Terms & Conditions mentioned herein along with the relevant supporting documents;
- "Applicant" means any person / company / institution / organisation that has made an application for registering its interest for selection and subsequent participation in Prelude for IJS 2018, but has not been selected to participate in Prelude for IJS 2018;
- "Council" or "The Council" means the Gem & Jewellery Export Promotion Council of India and includes its committees, sub-committees, members of such committees / sub-committees, executives, employees, directors, officers, contractors, sub-contractors and agents.
- "Prelude for IJS 2018" means a one day show before India International Jewellery show organized by the Council, wherein the Council shall showcase the top of the line jewellery of India in terms of design, innovation, craftsmanship, technology and quality to the global customers.
- "Selection Committee" means the committee comprising of such persons as identified by the Council for scrutiny of the Application & Structured Profile based on which an Applicant shall be selected or rejected for purpose of participating in Prelude for IJS 2018.
- "Slot" means the time allocated to a particular Participant in Prelude for IJS 2018;
- "Structured Profile" means the profile which the Applicant is required to submit along with the Application.
- "Participant" means any Applicant whose application for registration of

interest for selection and subsequent participation at Prelude for IJS 2018 has been accepted and includes Participant's employees, agents, representative, contractors, sub-contractors and / or sub-licensees.

- "Participation Fees" means the fees for participation as detailed in Clause 3 & 4 of Registration form.
- "T&Cs" means the Standard Terms & Conditions forming integral part of the Application and read in conjunction with the Registration Form at all times.

2. APPLICATION

For the purpose of participating in Prelude for IJS 2018 the Applicant shall submit the Application for registration of interest with complete details together with the relevant supporting documents / Annexure as indicated in the Application and the applicable Participation Fees.

3. PARTICIPATION & PARTICIPATION FEES

- The Council reserves all rights to accept or refuse any Application of any Applicant to participate in Prelude for IJS 2018. Selection or rejection and the allotment of the Slots are completely based on the discretion of the Selection Committee of the Council. All decisions of the Council to such effect shall be final and binding on the Applicant and the Participant. No reason for any such decision shall be given and no claim or objection from any Applicant in relation thereto shall be entertained.

- The Application form must be accompanied with a Deposit of 100% of total participation fees, either by way of Cheque or a Demand Draft, payable at par drawn in favour of The Gem & Jewellery Export Promotion Council, as a commitment towards the participation. Such Deposit shall be an interest free deposit.

- In the event, any Application is rejected by the Selection Committee, the Council shall return the interest free Deposit to the respective Applicant.

- In the event, the Application is selected by the Selection Committee, the Deposit will be converted as part of Participation fees. The Participant understands that the Participation Fees paid along with the Application and thereafter, shall not be refunded by the Council in any manner whatsoever, except for and in accordance to Article 4 pertaining to Cancellation Policy herein below.

4. CANCELLATION POLICY

- The Council reserves all rights to cancel the Prelude for IJS 2018 at any time without assigning any reason for such cancellation. In such an event, upon the Participant making a written application in this behalf, the Council shall refund the Participation Fees to the Participant, without any interest and to extent the fees remains unutilized for the purpose of attaining the objectives of Prelude for IJS 2018. Upon Council refunding such proportionate or entire fees, as the case may be, the Participant shall neither have nor shall the Participant make any further claims against the Council.
- Notwithstanding anything herein, the Participant canceling / withdrawing from its participation at Prelude for IJS 2018 at any time after selection shall not be entitled to refund of any nature & in any manner whatsoever and their entire Participation Fees shall stand forfeited in favour of the Council. The Participant hereby acknowledges, understands and agrees that upon happening of such an event the Participant shall not have any claim whatsoever against the Council.
- A waitlist will be created in process of selection if there are more applicants and same shall be informed from time to time to the Applicant registering the interest. Such waitlisted applicants will have the option of participation only against cancellation of slots or increase in the number of slots by the council and such applicants will be selected by the selection committee / the Council only.

5. SLOT ALLOCATION & USE

- The Selection Committee under consultation with the Council reserves all powers & rights to allocate a Slot as deemed fit and all decisions to such effect shall be final and binding. No change in Slot will be allowed after it has been allocated by the Selection Committee. No personal request or recommendation from any Participant to the Selection Committee to this effect will be entertained.
- The Council is entitled to, in its absolute discretion, to change the Slot allocated to a Participant or change the dates and / or venue of Prelude to IJS 2018, even though the same has been confirmed, and in such circumstances, the terms and conditions as laid down herein shall continue to bind the Council and the Participant. The Council shall inform the Participant of any such changes at least 1 day in advance of commencement of Prelude to IJS 2018.
- The Participant shall follow the code of conducts of show at Slots to be provided to the selected Participants directly by Council or through its appointed agent/s shall be published which shall form an integral part of this T&Cs.
- The Participation Fees are towards the Slot including the model(s), choreographer, make-up & hair stylist (only for the models), which are approved by the Council. Any requirement of the Participant as to the models other than the one approved by the Council will be under a prior written approval of the Council and at extra cost.
- No sale of jewellery or any other product will be allowed within the Prelude for IJS 2018 venue.
- The Participant along with their staff / assistant shall come to the Prelude for IJS 2018 venue for fittings prior to the show at a time allotted to them.
- Lunch or dinner will not be provided to the Participant Guests & staff. If any lunch or dinner is required the costs towards the same shall be as per actual and to be paid directly to the hotel.
- Any requirement of hotel rooms, should be informed to the Council officially in writing at least 30 (thirty) days prior to commencement of Prelude for IJS 2018. Any and all costs towards the same shall be charged at extra and to be paid in advance directly to the hotel. If the participant is bringing any show stoppers and their hotel accommodation and payment has to be paid directly by the participants itself.
- The Participant shall neither directly nor indirectly through any third party including their personal photographer / videographer shoot or capture (in digital form, movie or stills) the show at the venue. Any photographs or DVD will be provided after the completion of Prelude for IJS 2018, only under an advance written request made by the Participant.
- No presentation or speeches or audio-video display / relay equipment shall be allowed prior and post the shows.
- Press meet, if any, with the Participant & Show Stoppers shall be arranged only after completion of each show.
- No Participant will be allowed to bring in their personal or company PR team at the venue.
- No activity which, in the opinion of the Council may amount to a nuisance or annoyance to the public or other participants shall be caused by the Participant within the vicinity of the Prelude for IJS 2018 venue.
- The Participant & its staff will get badges & passes as per the allotment approved by the Council. In case of misuse/impersonation of badge(s) by any Participant or its staff member or authorized representative, such misused badge will be confiscated and no new badge will be issued in lieu of such confiscated badge(s).
- Each Participant is liable for its own security and any & all of its belongings. The Council shall not be responsible in any manner whatsoever for whatever security measurements that may be needed by the belongings of the Participant. The Council will have security at the Main Gate of the Venue only during opening hours & closing hours of the show day (i.e. from 4.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m.) plus security as may be required during the night time. Any claims of the Participant in this behalf shall not be entertained by the Council on any grounds whatsoever.
- No Participant shall be allowed to transfer, dispose of part with or otherwise sublet the whole or part of its Slot, whether for financial consideration or otherwise.

6. INSURANCE, INDEMNITY BY THE PARTICIPANT AND THE COUNCIL EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY

- The Participant must have, at all times (immediately prior during and after Prelude for IJS 2018) a valid and adequate insurance cover against theft, fire, public liability damage to property, personal injury third party loss, accidents, natural calamities, acts of God and such other risks normally insured against by the Participant and / or as the Council may require, from time to time, in connection with inter alia, the Participant's property including the valuables and its activities during Prelude for IJS 2018 (including the moving in and moving out periods). Every such insurance policy shall cover the Council as a co-assured and shall be presented to the Council as and when required and / or demanded by the Council. The Council shall not admit/accept any right to recourse either from the Participant and / or from its insurer. The Participant and / or its insurer hereby shall waive all its / their right to recourse, in favour of the Council. Further, the Participant shall take all necessary steps to incorporate in its insurance documents the relevant clauses to the effect that the Participant and / or its insurer shall not

subrogate and waive off any and all claims duly covered under such insurance policy (ies). The Council reserves the right to inspect every such insurance document to cross verify that the above requirements are met with and thus may call upon for the insurance documents for purpose of such inspection at any time prior during and after Prelude for IJS 2018.

- The Participant's property is brought to and showcased at, and removed from the Prelude for IJS 2018 Venue at the Participant's own risk and the Participant is responsible for the safety of all its property at all times.

- The Participant agrees to indemnify and keep the Council indemnified, safe and harmless, on demand, from and against, all and any actions, claims, demands, losses (including consequential losses), proceedings, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses incurred by or made against the Council in connection with (a) any breach, of any of these Terms, Rules and Regulations or any applicable laws and regulations, by the Participant or (b) any act, omission, default or negligence of or loss or damage caused by the Participant in connection with any other person, Prelude for IJS 2018 and its Venue.

- The Council shall not be liable for any losses (including consequential losses), damages, demands, costs, claims, charges or other expenses of any kind suffered or incurred by the Participant or any other person arising in connection with Prelude for IJS 2018 including without limitation, any theft, fire, use of the Prelude for IJS 2018 venue, defect in the Prelude for IJS 2018 venue however caused, cancellation or early closure of or delay in the opening or closing of the shows on any particular day of Prelude for IJS 2018 for whatever reason outside the control of the Council, including any natural calamity or any act of God, however arising. The Participant should insure against such matters. The Participant shall be solely liable to any third party for inter alia, any claims, injury or damage arising from its participating in Prelude for IJS 2018.

6.5 CANCELLATION CLAUSE:

If Prelude for IJS 2018 is cancelled or closed early for whatever reason beyond the control of the Council, the Council's performance under this contract shall be absolutely discharged and the Council shall not refund any payments (or a proportion thereof as appropriate) made by the Participant to the Council in relation to Prelude for IJS 2018 and shall not be liable for any losses (including consequential losses), damages, demands, costs, claims, charges or other expenses of any kind however arising in respect thereof. The Participant should insure against any such event occurring.

7. OWNERSHIP

- All rights in trademark design, logo, trade name, trade style pertaining to Prelude to IJS 2018, including all the logos belonging to the Council shall be exclusive property of the Council and the Applicant or Participant shall not in any manner whatsoever use or advertisement the same in any form, written, electronic or oral, for its personal gain. The Logo shall not be used at any time by the Applicant or the Participant in any manner whatsoever.

The Council in good faith believes on the representation of the Participant that:

- All the designs, brands, labels, showcased by it at Prelude to IJS 2018 are exclusive property of the Participant and the Participant owns and enjoys all rights over the same exclusively.

- The jewellery designs / works showcased / displayed by the Participant are original ones and are not copied from any source and does not infringe upon any copyright, trademark, design, patent or any intellectual property right of any third party.

- The Participant will be responsible and liable for and will indemnify the Council and keep the Council indemnified, safe and harmless at all times, against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, costs (including reasonable legal fees), charges, expenses, proceedings and actions of any nature whatsoever made or instituted against or caused to or suffered by the Council directly or indirectly by reason of:- any third party claim arising out of breach of representation made by the Participant under Clause 7.2 hereinabove;

- any wrongful, incorrect, dishonest, criminal, fraudulent or negligent work, default, failure, misfeasance, bad faith, disregard of its obligations hereunder act or omission of or by the Participant and/or its staff, representative, and/or;
- any breach of the Participant's obligations here under including, without limitation, any breach concerning to any representations or warranties made or given by the Participant, in respect of its participation at Prelude to IJS 2018.

- To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law the Council shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, special, consequential, or incidental damages (including but not limited to damages for loss of business profits, business interruption, loss of business information, and the like) arising out of the terms herein, any documents referenced herein, or any addenda or amendment hereto;

8. FORCE MAJEURE

The Council shall not be responsible for any failure to perform its obligation under this T&Cs due to unforeseen circumstances or due to causes beyond its control even after exertion of commercially reasonable efforts to prevent such failure, which failure may include, but not be limited to, acts of God, fire or floods, war, riots, embargoes, strikes, lockouts, acts of any Government authority, delays in obtaining licenses or rejection of applications under the Statutes.

9. ARBITRATION & GOVERNING LAW

It is hereby agreed by and between the Parties hereto that in the event of any dispute or difference arising between the Parties with regard to the terms and conditions of this contract or these T&Cs or relating to the interpretation thereof and / or the implementation of respective rights obligations and/or responsibilities of the Parties hereto, the same shall be referred to arbitration, in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force. The Arbitral Tribunal shall comprise of a Sole Arbitrator who shall be appointed by the Council. The arbitration shall be held in Mumbai and the proceedings shall be conducted in the English Language. The laws of the Republic of India shall govern these T&Cs and the parties agree that the appropriate Courts at Mumbai shall have exclusive Jurisdiction in the matters arising hereunder.

10. MISCELLANEOUS

- Any work carried out in India must be in accordance with the current law and regulations of the Civil & Government of the State and Union. Any contravention of these conditions will be stopped immediately. The Council will not be held responsible for any extra cost or delay so caused.

- No wet food or drink may be taken near the ramp and / or inside the hall.
- No sale will be permitted during Prelude to IJS 2018. If any Participant is found selling any goods, the Council shall take such action as it deems fit including debarring the Participant from participating in any future like events which may be organised by the Council.
- All applications shall be made on the basis of these Terms, Rules and Regulations and the Application as a whole.
- By signing on this Application the Participant are deemed to have signed and agreed to these T&Cs;
- These T&Cs apply to every kind of events forming part of Prelude to IJS 2018 organized by the Council, whether or not specially referred to in these T&Cs whether or not performed at additional cost and whether or not currently being performed by the Council for the Participants of Prelude to IJS 2018, unless it is performed pursuant to another written contract with the Council. These T&Cs contain the entire and only agreement between the Council and the Participant in relation to the subject matter hereof and all prior and collateral representations, warranties, promises and conditions made by the Council have been merged herein. No representation, warranty, promise or condition not incorporated herein shall be binding upon either party. These T&Cs shall bind and inure to the benefit of the parties and their successors. The Participant shall not assign these T&Cs in favour of any third party without the Council's prior written consent. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction holds any provision of these T&Cs invalid or unenforceable, it will not invalidate or render unenforceable any other provisions hereof and the same will continue to be valid. No waiver or amendment of these T&Cs shall be binding on either party unless it is in writing and signed by the authorized officials of both the parties.
- These T&Cs may be subject to changes due to any reasons whatsoever, in which case the same shall be intimated to the Participant. The Participant agrees to abide by any such changes and modifications in the Prelude to IJS 2018 rules & regulations, other terms & conditions governing Prelude to IJS 2018.
